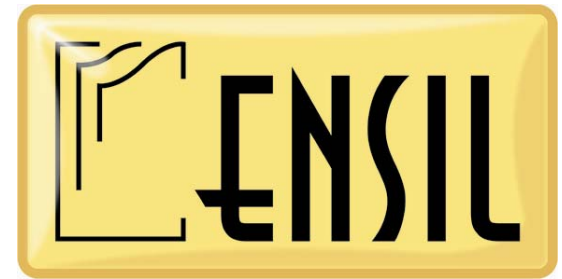


Stichting ENSIL is for school library professionals, associations and others with an interest in school libraries and information literacy throughout Europe. In this context Europe is considered to include the following countries:
